



2025-2026 KCAA Scholarship Application Guidelines

School Requirements:

- School must have been a KCAA Member in good standing with the league and actively participating in KCAA Sports for the prior two academic years.
- School shall not be actively pursuing KHSAA Membership.

Athlete Requirements:

- Student must be enrolled in a KCAA school that meets the above requirements.
- Student must be graduating in the spring of award and attending college or vocational school in the fall of the same year.
- Student must have participated in at least three full seasons of KCAA athletic competition during high school.
- Student must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 (on a 4.0 scale) or equivalent.
- Student must submit application with all supporting documentation.

Awards:

- The number and amounts of scholarships awarded will be determined by funds generated in the KCAA Scholarship Golf Scramble.
- Checks will be made payable to the school the student is attending.
- Any winner that ultimately opts not to attend college or vocational school or will forfeit his/her scholarship.

Miscellaneous:

- There is no cap on the number of students from any one school that will be eligible for scholarship.
- Scholarship applications must be received by the KCAA by January 31, 2026.
- Scholarship awards to be determined by a panel of judges (TBD).
- Scholarship winners will be notified sometime between the 2026 KCAA Varsity State Basketball Tournament and May 1, 2026.
